Resistance Input to Current Output (Loop Powered)

The RTI converts a 3-wire resistance signal to an analog output by using current loop power (two wire). The RTI is reverse polarity protected and offers linear tracking of a 3-wire resistance input against the standard output signal of a 4-20mA (current source). The RTI is small in size and self-powered. These features lends its use to remote mounting for feedback signals from a valve or damper motor indicating its position.
